Collaboration in IAS management

7. Collaborate with local vocational schools that teach gardening or natural & environmental protection



Vocational qualifications in horticulture and natural and environmental protection include compulsory and optional studies related to IAS.

Municipalities and schools have a good opportunity to engage in mutually beneficial collaboration.

Do this

Organise a meeting with a local school to map the opportunities of the municipality to offer students IASrelated traineeships or to do a thesis.

In addition, the municipality can benefit from students practising IAS control work on real-life IAS sites.

Benefits of the action

The municipality benefits from IAS practical training by students, while students get to showcase their skills and gain practical work experience.
