3. Participate or improve the participation level of your municipality in the Soolotalkoot campaign



The Soolotalkoot campaign allows the citizens to combat IAS when and where it best suits them, with permission from the land owner.

Municipalities can utilise the campaign by offering IAS suitable for voluntary work and key target sites for combating IAS in the area.

Benefits of the action

The Soolotalkoot campaign can also attract those volunteers interested in combating IAS who cannot attend organised IAS weeding events due to unsuitable location or time.

Do this

Encourages citizens early on in spring to participate in the campaign. Communicate the progress throughout the summer.

You can establish permanent Soolotalkoot target sites by supplying the site with a signboard (made with the help of a template) and instructions for volunteers.

You can also challenge local associations and other municipalities to join in.
