

7. Maximise the benefit to nature by steering control activities to nature conservation areas

Focusing control activities to conservation areas and other valuable nature sites threatened by IAS renders better outcomes for biodiversity than control measures performed in urban and built-up areas.

Do this

Map the IAS situation of conservation areas in the municipal region and prioritise in which order the identified sites are processed based on the species and urgency.

Organise the control work to be done by the municipality itself or by contractors, or alternatively in collaboration with local citizens or associations.

Benefits of the action

IAS control performed at valuable nature sites will also help the municipality achieve other goals related to nature conservation and biotope management.
